

2020 COVID-19 Lions Club Tube Rental Procedures:

- All employees required to wash their hands thoroughly before logging in to timeclock.
- All employees encouraged to wash hands multiple times throughout the day.
- All Tube Rental employees are required to wear nitrile gloves while at work
- All tubes are sanitized after each use.
- Sneeze guards installed around each cash register station.
- Six-foot social distancing is in place, with prevalent signage.
- Limit of 5 customers allowed in Tubing Store at a time
- One person per group allowed in Rental lines while others must wait away from the building
- We limit the number of people in each line when renting tubes.
- Tube Rental employees will inflate customers' personal tubes to minimize opportunity to spread possible contamination
- Line for those waiting for tubes to be inflated has been moved away from the building to avoid contact with people on sidewalk.
- Line for those picking up Rental Tubes has been moved alongside and off of sidewalks near Tube Rental to avoid interaction with people on sidewalk.
- Masks are provided for all employees who wish to wear them
- Busses and vans are utilized at 50% capacity or less
- Every bus and van interior are completely sanitized after each trip with passengers.
- A limit of 5 persons per group at a time for our customers to be placed into the river, with gaps of 30 seconds between each group.

Note: These precautions will be modified and/or improved where advisable and will be adjusted to match changing conditions in the community of San Marcos, Hays County, and the State of Texas.
